

All things change but the Almighty


Full cocoon - now breaking open Folded wings untried, unsure, Now unfolding, flexing, flying; God, how great and wise you are!

There is a desire that we begin processing the cross at all worship services beginning in Lent. If you are interested, please contact any Worship Committee member.





Mission Endowment Fund

The Mission Endowment Fund (MEF) team distributed funds to all projects that were submitted to the MEF.

The team met in February to discern how to distribute our 2021 earnings. The fund earned \$3,234.18 last year. Per our bylaws, 90% of the earnings can be disbursed (in this case, \$2,910.67) and the remaining amount reinvested.


