Deadline for signing up is May 1. If there are not enough volunteers, the sale will be cancelled. Sign up is posted on the board in the Gathering Area.



Here is the schedule of speakers (many thanks for them being willing to share their stories):


May 8 – Ed Markwart – A long road from Poland and Germany May 15 – Pauline Obasi – From Nigeria to the U.S.
