

represented in each of your donations.



#### News from Barry County Community Mental Health

If you or a loved one are in need of mental health services there have been some improvements in access to care. The following is a letter we received from Christa Wetzel, the new community outreach specialist...

"I am reaching out to you, to inform you of some HUGE changes at our agency.


For the last two years BCCMHA has been working to become a Certified Community Behavioral Health Clinic (CCBHC). With this certification we can provide integrated services to jointly address medical and behavioral health needs. Our care extends to all ages and is provided in a person-centered, family-driven, and youth-guided manner. Individuals, families, and youth have an empowered, decision-making role in how their care is delivered.


With this change, our mission has expanded to serve all individuals regardless of diagnosis, severity, residency, or insurance. We can proudly say no one will be denied care. BCCMHA accepts both insurance and self-pay patients, in addition to Medicaid/Healthy Michigan/Mi Child, and works with everyone to assist in understanding cost, services, eligibility, insurance, referrals, and payment options.

Please know there is help available for all members of the community, including those you serve. BCCMHA provides outreach crisis care, case management, community-based services, psychiatric services with adult and pediatric medication management, outpatient therapy, and numerous other services. Expanded services now include care management, care coordination, and primary care screenings."
