

Hastings Women's Club is once again collecting plastic bags for a community project: making tote bags and selling them for \$15 each. All funds collected will be donated to the Pierce Cedar Creek Institute's Science Strong program. They bring Environmental Programs into the schools beginning at the 3rd grade level. If children are exposed to this issue at a young age, they are more likely to carry the benefits and practices into adulthood.
